All users must display a valid Transfer Station decal that is per manently affixed to their vehicles windshield Decals are available from the Town O erk's office during regular business hours. Transfer Station employees may turn a way vehicles without valid decals, or patrons who refuse to comply with the Limington Solid Waste Ordinance. Construction Debris is limited to two cubic yards per month. Contractors are not authorized to off load at the Transfer Facility. Residents with large remodel or demo projects should contract private haulers.
